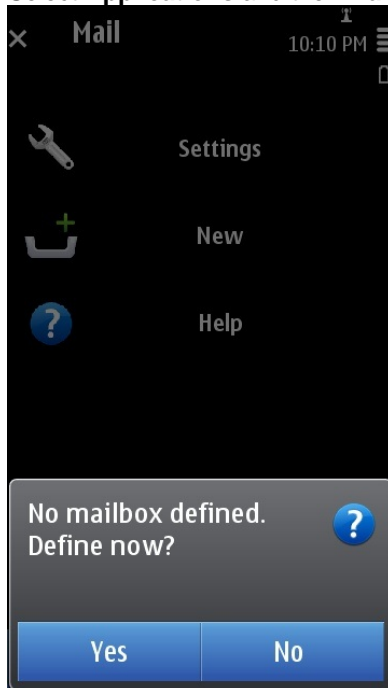


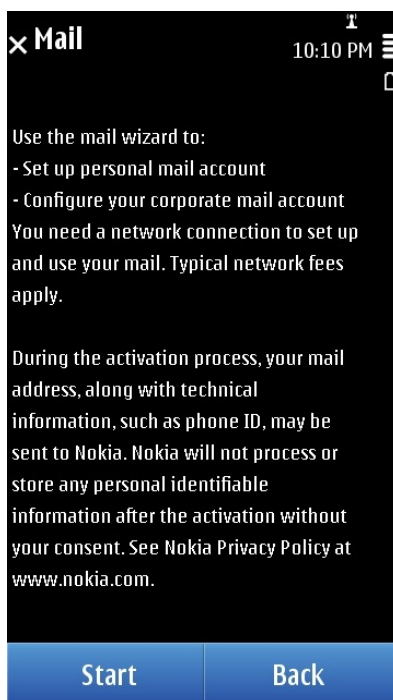
Setting up Mail for Exchange for Nokia

To set up the Exchange account, on the phone access the main menu (by pressing the button in the bottom left-hand corner on the front of the unit).

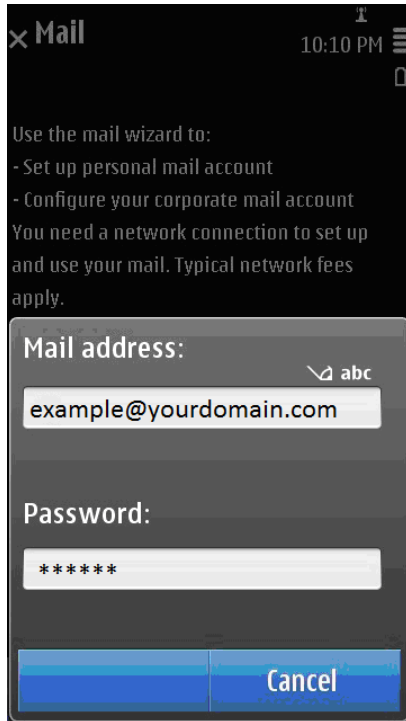
Select **Applications** and then **Mail**:



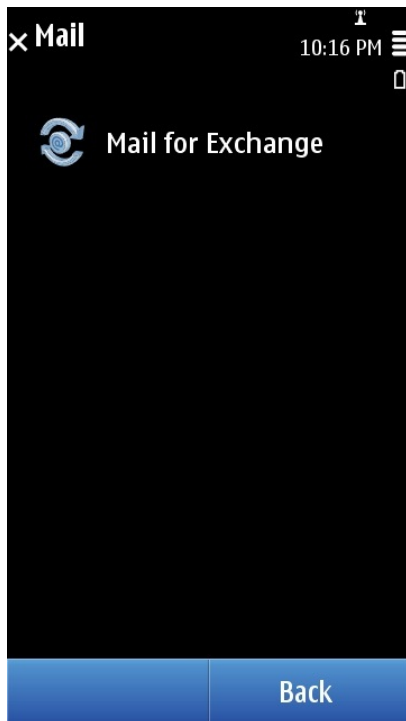
You will be prompted to create a new mail box, select **Yes**:



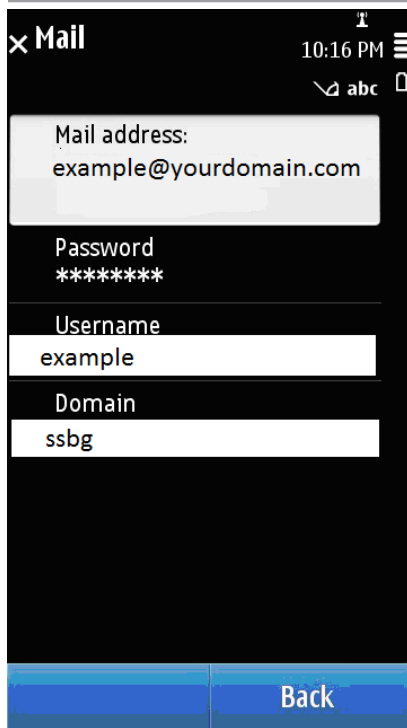
Select **Start**:



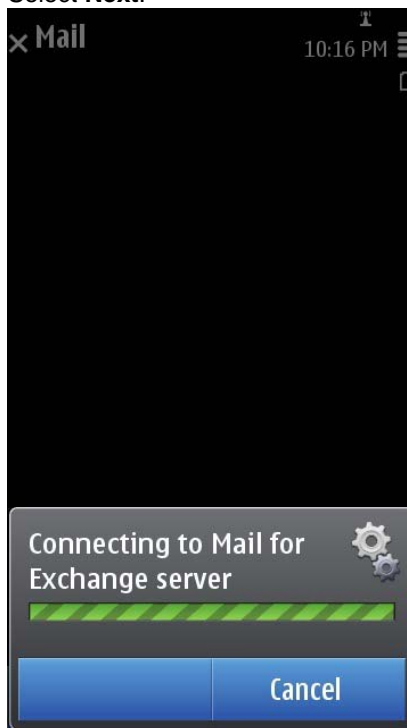
Enter in your Exchange email address and your password, the same password you use to log into your webmail. Select **Next**:



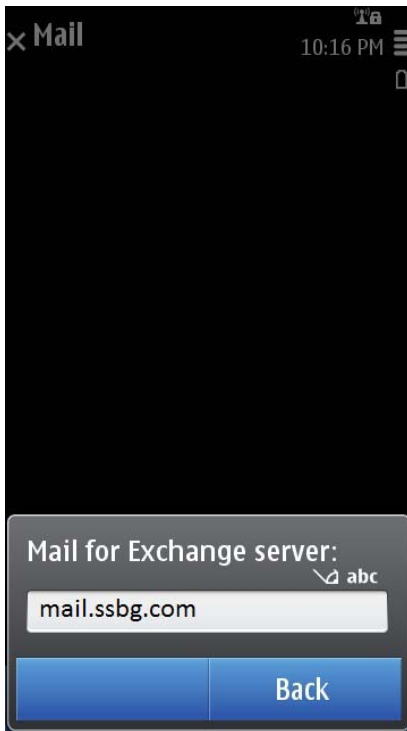
Select **Mail for Exchange** as the type of email account and then **Next**:



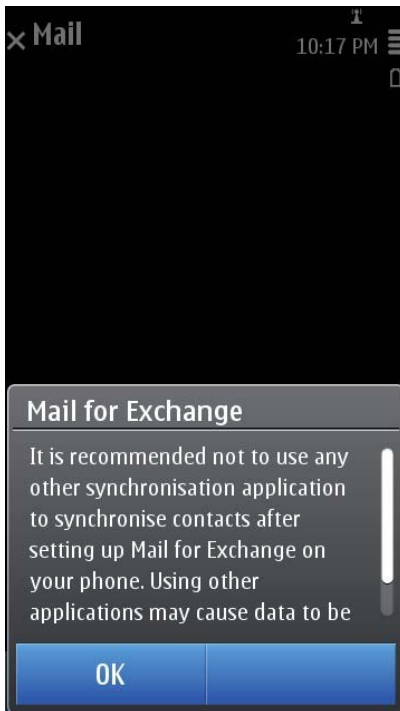
Add your username and domain. Again the username will be the same as that used to log into webmail.
Select **Next**:



The client will then attempt to determine the details of the Exchange server from the email address, if it is unable to determine the information automatically, you will be prompted to enter in the name of the mail server:



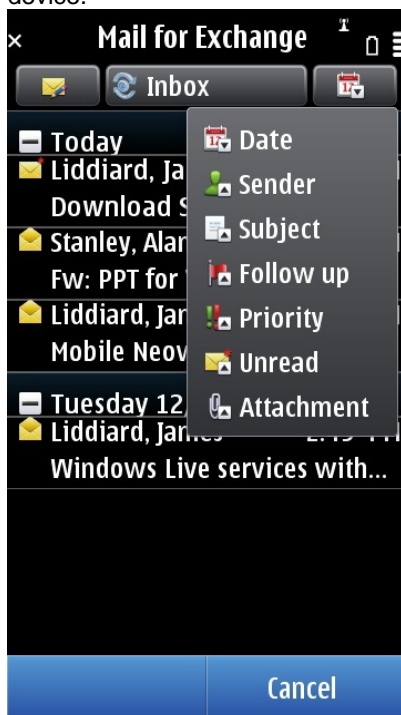
Enter in the name of the server, "mail.ssbg.com" Select **Next**:



Select **OK**, you will then be prompted to specify which mailbox folders you want to synchronize:



Select the appropriate folders and select **Next**. Your mail and selected folders will now be synced with your device.



And all mail box folders can be viewed:
